The successful candidate will support the health needs of the clients of the OHNSW Community Programs including through education and support for the Alcohol and Other Drug Treatment Team and through a community nursing case management approach.

This position will assist our clients to access additional care for their health, mental health and wellbeing, including particularly through supported referral into primary care and specialist care.

Key Responsibilities:

- Deliver community nursing support and case management including supported referral and access to primary care, specialist medical, mental health and wellbeing support, chronic disease management, preventative health care.
- Support client ambulatory (home) withdrawal management in conjunction with GP.
- Deliver occasional general nursing care in line with OHNSW Model of Care and guidelines.
- Provide individual and ad hoc health promotion and health education.
- Work closely with OHNSW Community Programs AOD staff to ensure effective communication and high-quality care.
- Liaise with other specialist, external agencies, and medical practitioners (for e.g., partner GP, other specialist in the community) to meet needs of clients and support continuity of care.

Selection Criteria:

- Current professional registration with AHPRA.
- Relevant Nursing qualification.
- General Nursing experience.
- Preferred - demonstrated experience working with people with significant Alcohol and Other Drug or Mental Health issues.
- Preferred - Mental Health nursing experience.
- Preferred - Community nursing including case management, group facilitation and/or health promotion.
- Preferred - Experience working within a non-government AOD treatment program.
- Computer literacy including understanding of MS Office Suite and use of Client Management Systems.
- Current NSW Drivers Licence.
- The ability to obtain a suitable National Police check.
