Odyssey House NSW is seeking an Aboriginal Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Worker with experience in the AOD sector or working with Community to work within a small Community Programs team.

This position will assist in the development, implementation, and delivery of an AOD service model that is culturally appropriate and meets the needs of Indigenous Communities within the Sydney region. The successful candidate will be mainly based at Hornsby, with occasional travel to our other sites and to other services. Full-time to June 2022 with highly likely extension for a further 2 to 3 years. NFP salary sacrificing available.

Selection Criteria:

- Do you have a relevant VET qualification (like a CERT IV or Diploma), or a Uni Degree?
- What is your experience working with Community members with AOD or mental health issues?
- What is your understanding of health issues that affect Indigenous peoples?
- Have you delivered culturally appropriate health promotion programs?
- What is your experience of undertaking assessments of people?
- Have you got experience working within a non-government AOD, Mental Health, or Aboriginal Community controlled Program?
- What is your computer literacy like?
- Have you used client management systems before?
- Do you hold a current NSW Driver's Licence?
- Do you have or can you get an acceptable Criminal History Check and Working with Children Clearance for paid employment?

Odyssey House NSW considers that being Aboriginal or a Torres Strait Islander is a genuine occupational requirement for this position under s 14 of the Anti-Discrimination Act 1977 (NSW).
